## SafeMinds to Present Latest Evidence Exposing Vaccine-Autism Link at Tomorrow's Congressional Hearing

Washington, D.C.—SafeMinds—America's leading scientific organization investigating the risks that mercury-containing medical products pose to children—will give Congress an update tomorrow on the research linking America's autism epidemic to a preservative in many vaccines, Thimerosal. SafeMinds will provide the testimony at the request of the Subcommittee on Human Rights and Wellness, chaired by Congressman Dan Burton (R-Ind.), which is hosting the hearing.

The hearing is scheduled for tomorrow, September 8, 2004, at 10 a.m. in Room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building in Washington, D.C.

"Chairman Burton and the subcommittee have been tireless heroes in the fight to uncover the scientific truth behind the vaccine-autism link," said Lyn Redwood, RN, MSN, president of SafeMinds. "We are proud to provide Congress with an overview of five years of research-born scientific evidence linking Thimerosal-containing vaccines and autism.

"We are also pleased that the subcommittee will explore the consistent discrepancy between the statements and policies of the CDC (Centers for Disease Control and Prevention) and the findings of numerous independent researchers who study the vaccine-autism link."
